



TIPS TO HAVING A SUCCESSFUL HUNTING TRIP

- Do your research before choosing an outfitter. Ask questions.
- Make sure you fully understand your agreement with the outfitter. Small details such as arrival & departure times, license information, price and extra fees (taxes) are items you should be familiar with.
- Realize where and what you are hunting.
- Familiarize yourself with your gun and its capabilities. Know your limits.
- Have your gun, muzzleloader or bow sighted in.
- Communicate with your guide.
- **DON'T** make a competition out of your hunt. Only one can shoot the biggest animal in camp, so take the animal you will be happy with.
- Maintain a positive attitude. Be patient.
- Use good field sense.
